2022 Call for Nomination: The 2nd Kadar-Sheba Prize for Excellence in Research

Dear Medical Community,

Thanks to the generosity, visionary mission and endless inspiration of the Naomi Foundation, we are humbled and honored to launch the second RFA for the **Kadar –Sheba Prize for Excellence in Research.** This year, the Kadar-Sheba Prize recognizes an exceptional physician-scientist at the national level, within the biomedical community of the entire State of Israel, for their groundbreaking scientific achievements.

The Naomi Foundation is dedicated to reimagining education and catalyzing groundbreaking research. Naomi Prawer Kadar, Ph.D., z"l, the inspiration and driving force behind the Naomi Foundation, was a lifelong educator and scholar who inspired her students, colleagues, and all who knew her to reach their potential. Naomi's spirit and contributions continue to make a profound impact on the lives of thousands around the world through the initiatives of the Naomi Foundation.

Inspired to promote and accelerate excellence in biomedical research, the Naomi Foundation has decided to celebrate the scientific achievements of a leading physician-scientist within all Israeli medical centers and to honor her/him with the Annual **Kadar-Sheba Prize for Excellence in Research**.

The Foundation will award \$100,000 to a single recipient, with \$75,000 dedicated to support research and \$25,000 as a personal award to the recipient.

The prize committee will review all nominations and will announce the 2022 Recipient of the Award no later than November 2022.

Award Criteria

Eligible for nomination are established physician-scientists from all Israeli medical centers, holding an MD or MD/PhD degree, conducting outstanding basic and/or

translational research with global scientific impact in addition to an active practice of medicine, fulfilling the following criteria:

- High level of achievements and peer recognition of research activities.
- The research activities conducted at Israeli medical centers.
- Nominees will be evaluated for:
 - Publications in high visibility/impact scientific journals/books
 - o Receiving of competitive research grants as a principal investigator
 - Performance in teaching and supervising graduate students
 - Active participation (delivering lectures and/or panel moderators) in international conferences.
 - Evaluations and reports from colleagues and mentees

Submission Deadline: September 23rd, 2022 @5pm.

Nomination should include detailed curriculum vitae of the nominee with list of all publications, grants and students mentored by the nominee, 3 letters of recommendations and a cover letter highlighting the key achievements of the nominee. Both Self and Non-Self Nominations are welcomed.

The laureate of the Kadar-Sheba Prize for Excellence in Research will participate in a presentation coaching session, and will film a short TED-style video highlighting their research, to be presented at the Award ceremony which will be scheduled by the end of the year at Sheba Medical Center.
